ENTRY:

Per MVC Rules: The Club list(s) of race entries for U12/10 Series races should be entered into the Split Second Timing National/FIS Software. Each club must send this file to the race secretary of the hosting mountain by the WEDNESDAY prior to the race (Wednesday, January 23).

<u>FEE</u>: \$30 paid via cash or check only; no credit cards accepted.

Start time: 9:30 a.m. first run

Running order: U10 girls (U8s included), U10 boys (U8s included), U12 girls, U12 boys.

<u>REGISTRATION</u>: Registration begins at 7:30 a.m. and is located in the Sunshine Room, downstairs in the Pico Mountain base lodge; look for directional signs to the Sunshine Room.

<u>FACILITIES</u>: **Please use the Pico Mountain base lodge facilities**. The Pico Ski Club is a private facility and not for use by visiting athletes, coaches, family members.... Thank you for respecting their privacy and this policy.

<u>Pico Mountain Staff</u>: Please be respectful of resort employees, i.e. parking lot attendants, lift operators.... and their appropriate directive.

<u>Mandatory Coaches' Meeting</u>: 8:15 a.m. in the downstairs of the Pico Ski Club, located next to Little Pico Triple Chair. All coaches are required to sign-in, with his/her USSA number, in order to receive a lift pass. Coaches lift passes will be distributed at the meeting.

<u>Pico Mountain Lift Ticket Fee</u>: \$45 for immediate family members of racers on start list (limited to 2 tickets, non-refundable). Tickets are purchased at the main ticket office located between the parking lot and the base lodge.

<u>Memberships</u>: A reminder that all athletes and coaches are required to have current USSA and VARA memberships.

Bibs: Please return bibs to bib collector in the finish area to avoid being assessed a "lost" fee of \$75.

<u>Awards</u>: Presentation of awards will be from the Pico Ski Club deck following the ski-around, approximately 1 hour after the conclusion of the race.
