Medical Plan

Inverness & Brambles

Facility:

The Inverness and Brambles trails at Sugarbush/Mt. Ellen are staffed by Sugarbush Ski Patrol for all races hosted by GMVS. There is a patroller in the upper lift terminal building of the Inverness Quad chairlift when Inverness Quad is running. The direct line to that building is (802) 583-6286. If only the T-bar is in use, patrol will be in the base lodge. Emergency number for Sugarbush Dispatch and Patrol is 583-6567.

Sugarbush Resort has an examination clinic in the Mt. Ellen Base Lodge. This facility is used to examine skiers taken off the slopes by patrol, and here Patrol will determine if a patient needs further attention, either via ambulance (Mad River Valley Ambulance Service) to Central Vermont Medical Center in Berlin, VT (CVMC-25-30 min drive), or to the UVM Medical Clinic at Lincoln Peak (5 minutes away by car).

The Patrol is also in contact with the DART helicopter rescue unit of Dartmouth-Hitchcock Medical Center in Lebanon, NH.

In case of injury:

- -Ski Patrol is contacted either by calling the Inverness patrol station, the Dispatch # for Sugarbush (802) 583-6567, or by start personnel informing the Inverness patroller.
- -Ski Patrol is notified of the location and nature of the injury.
- -Once on scene, Ski Patrol follows Sugarbush protocol for patient care, including, but not limited to: first aid, CPR, sled transport and notification of ambulance or helicopter evacuation.
- -Depending on the severity of the injury, the patient will be transported to the base area for evaluation and/or transport to the UVM clinic, CVMC or Dartmouth-Hitchcock.
