

# Race Announcement- George Tormey Challenge Dual SL

## Race Format:

- Race Trail: Practice Slope (Racers should use T-Bar Lift)
- Single Panel Dual Slalom (Dual Format)
- 2 runs Men & Women (running order U12 Women, U12 Men, U14 Women, U14 Men)
  - 1<sup>st</sup> run – Random Order
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> run – Reverse Bib order (within each age category)
- Run-off in the afternoon – (Top 8 athletes in each gender, and age bracket qualify)

- 7:15 ..... Jury and Course Setting Chair Lift
- 7:30 – 8:30 .... Registration at the SNSC Clubhouse (Register and pay online)
- 8:15 ..... Team Captain's Meeting (In front of Score Board)
- 8:30 - 9:15 ..... Course Inspection
- 9:30 ..... First Race Run (Evens – Red, Odds – Blue)
- 10:30 ..... Second Race Run (Evens – Blue, Odds – Red)
- After 2<sup>nd</sup> run – Coaches Race (coaches interested in racing sign up at the Team Captain's meeting)
- 11:30 ..... BBQ and Bib Draw
- 12:30 ..... Run Off Start (top 8 athletes in each age and gender, based off fastest single run)
- Awards - 30 minutes after completion of Run OFF

**Registration, Bib Pickup, Lodge Space:** Please collect your bib from registration at the front window at the SNSC Clubhouse between 7:30-8:30 AM. The **entry fee will be \$35**, and all athletes must register and pay online at [www.admskiracing.com](http://www.admskiracing.com). Online registration is open from 5:00 PM on March 8<sup>th</sup> and closes 11:59 PM on March 12<sup>th</sup>. Please use the Base lodge to get ready and store your gear because we have limited space in the ski club and a full slate of weekend programs taking place. \$59 Parent tickets will available at registration.

**Awards:** Awards will be 30 minutes after the completion of the Run-off. Awards will be given based on the combined time of an athlete's two morning times. Awards will be given for the top 10 Overall U12 Girls, U12 Boys, U14 girls, and U14 boys. Awards for the run off will be swag and bragging rights. Team awards will be based on place points of the top 3 results of each club, in each age group and gender. (i.e. 3 best U12 girls finishes, 3 best U12 boys finishes, 3 best U14 girls finishes, and best 3 U14 boys finishes)

**BBQ Lunch:** SNSC will provide a BBQ lunch to all the athletes and coaches. This will be located next to the SNSC Clubhouse. Extra BBQ tickets for parents and siblings will be available at registration for \$10.

**Directions to Smugglers:** Smugglers Notch is located on route 108 S. The only access is from the North during the winter since the notch road is closed. From Route 15 you turn onto route 108 S in Jeffersonville and follow it up to the Smugglers Notch Resort. To get to the upper mountain you continue past the main entrance to the resort up route 108.

Parking will be on your right and the driveway to the base lodge will be on your left. If you wish you can continue past these options to the upper parking lot which is around the corner up to where the notch road is closed (this is ski in and out access only)

**Parking:** Parking is available in the two main lots across from the base lodge driveway. The Upper Parking lot is available for racers or coaches that want to ski from their car and ski back to it at the end of the day. Please don't park in the club member parking lot at the end of our driveway.

**Other Information:** Please keep the trail in front of the SNSC clubhouse clear of people and skis. Please make sure all skis are place on racks. Please lower safety bars while riding lifts. Do not weave on the T-Bar, and stay in the tracks under the cable. No Dogs allowed on the hill, please leave them at home.
