



**Cochran's Ski Club**  
**Town Meeting Day Slalom**  
**March 3, 2020**

**Race Format:**

- Age groups: U8 (2012 & 2013 birthdays) and U10 (2010 & 2011 birthdays)
- Race Trail: I-89
- Panel Slalom
- 2 Runs Boys and Girls:
  - 1<sup>st</sup> run-bib order- U8 girls, U10 girls, U8 boys, U10 boys (random within age groups)
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> run- reverse bib order within age/gender, on new course

**Race Day Schedule:**

- Registration/Bib Pick-Up: 8:00 – 9:00
- Jury and Course Setting: 8:00 lift
- Lift open for athletes: 8:30
- Captain's Meeting: 8:45 at the finish area
- Course Inspection: 9:00- 9:45
- First Run: Girls 10:00, immediately followed by Boys
- Second Run: approximately 1:00
- Coaches' Race immediately following boys 2<sup>nd</sup> run (\*more info below)
- Awards: 15 minutes or less after completion of coaches' race (top 10 U8, top 10 U10, each run, each gender)

**Coaches' Race:** A Town Meeting Day tradition! At least one coach from each club should plan to race (don't forget your helmet!). Sign up at registration or team captain's meeting. Bibs will be distributed at the start.

**Registration:** Please collect your bib from the ticket booth (gray building to the left of the lodge) between 8:00 and 9:00 am. All racers must be USSA and VARA members and be represented by an NVC coach. Your bib is your lift ticket. Coach tickets can be picked up at the snack bar in the lodge.

**Race Fee:** \$15, cash or check at bib pickup. Make checks to Cochran's Ski Club. Credit card payment available by advance registration on AdminSkiRacing.com. This link closes Sunday 3/1 at noon. Any payments after this time must be cash or check.

**Parent Lift Tickets:** Parent tickets are available in the lodge for \$10. Kids 5 and under ski free with the purchase of a parent ticket.

**Directions to Cochran's:** From Interstate 89 at Exit 11 in Richmond proceed east on Route 2 to Richmond Village. Turn right at the stop light onto Bridge Street. Continue on Bridge Street over the red bridge to the Old Round Church (on left). Just past the Round Church turn left on Cochran Road.

Drive approximately one mile; the ski area is on the right. **Please obey posted speed limits on Cochran Road as Richmond Police patrol it regularly.**

**Parking:** Upper and lower parking lots available. Parking space is limited. If possible, please carpool. A limited amount of drop off parking is available in the upper parking lot. Please clear the drop off area after dropping off your racer. **Please do not park on Cochran Road; we have been informed cars will be towed if parked on the road.**
