**Stratton Mountain Mask Policy:** Masks are required in all public places.

**Lodge Access Information:** Stratton Resort has restrooms available at all open lodges. Dining at a table requires a reservation. Tables can be booked at 30-minute increments through Open Table. Tables cannot be pulled together, even if the 2 groups are part of a cohort.

**Lift Line/Lift Riding Information:** Masks must be worn properly at all times in the lift lines. Cohorts who rode in the same vehicle may ride the lift together using full capacity. Otherwise, the resort will fill the lifts at 50% capacity. The safety bar must be down per VT State Law.

**No Spectator rule:**

To be clear, the State of Vermont does not allow spectators at practices or events. Section 9.1 of the ACCD Restart Guidelines states: (See attached)

“Prohibit spectators; only “key personnel” – players, coaches and staff – are allowed to attend team-based activities.

- Guardians must wait in their vehicles and to avoid socializing with other guardians at practices.”

Furthermore, the guidance links to the Snow Sports Competition Rules developed by our working group which further states: “Spectators and visitors shall not be allowed.”
