COVID Policies:

- All guidance promulgated by U.S. Ski & Snowboard, the State of Vermont, and VARA apply. See <u>U.S. Ski & Snowboard</u> <u>COVID-19 Alpine Domestic Competitions Guidance</u>, <u>Vermont Work Safe Guidance</u>: <u>Section 9.1 – Sports and Organized</u> <u>Sports</u>, and <u>Vermont Snowsports Competition Guidance</u>.
- Race entries will be limited to 100 athletes. Wait Listed athletes will be added per U.S. Ski & Snowboard rules.
- No spectators/parents allowed. Only pre-registered coaches may attend.
- Masks are required in all public places, and must be worn properly at all times in the lift lines.
- Sugarbush Resort lodges are not to be used by coaches or athletes for any purpose (including bag storage). It is suggested that the athletes return to their cars/vans between runs for warming and food OR rent a base cabin at https://www.sugarbush.com/plan/lodging/base-cabins/.
- All Lifts will be loaded at 50% capacity at all times. The safety bar must be down per VT State Law.
- <u>Vermont State travel restrictions</u> apply.

COVID Pre-Screening Protocols:

In order to be eligible to race, all ATHLETES must complete the following:

- 1. Sign the Sugarbush Resort attestation. This should arrive in parents' email inboxes directly from Sugarbush Resort with a confirmed ticket purchase and a link to the attestation.
- Complete the <u>GMVS Pre-Screen Questionnaire</u> on Saturday, February 27th (48 hours prior to the Team Captains' Meeting).

Additionally, all COACHES must complete the following:

- 1. Sign the Sugarbush Resort attestation. This should arrive in coaches' email inboxes directly from Sugarbush Resort with a confirmed ticket purchase and a link to the attestation.
- Complete the <u>GMVS Pre-Screen Questionnaire</u> on Saturday, February 27th (48 hours prior to the Team Captains' Meeting).
- 3. Complete the <u>Team Captains Attestation</u> (listing each athlete represented) no earlier than 24 hours prior to the start of competition.

Additional Information

- U.S. Ski & Snowboard and VARA entry protocols prevail.
- A \$100 Fee will be strictly enforced for failure to return a bib.
- All race documentation will be posted on https://livetiming.usskiandsnowboard.org/.
- Times will be displayed digitally only (via livetiming & onsite Digital Display Boards).
- Please respect all posted Sugarbush rules and regulations. Tickets will be pulled for non-compliance.
- No indoor bag storage or changing areas will be provided (unless renting a warming hut).
- Porta-Loo toilets available behind warming huts. Restrooms also available in Mt. Ellen Lodge.
