Stratton Mountain Mask Policy:

Masks are required in all public places.

Lodge Access Information:

Stratton Resort has restrooms available at all open lodges. All racers and families should use the upstairs of Mid Mountain lodge during the race. This area has been designated for racers and their families.

Masks are mandatory while in the lodge unless actively eating or drinking.

Lift Line/Lift Riding Information:

Masks must be worn properly at all times while riding in the Gondola. Masks are not required to ride the chairlifts, but the safety bar must be down per VT State Law.

Stratton's Spectator Policy:

In an effort to maintain the safest race environment possible, the mountain is restricting the race area, (including the finish corral) to only "key personnel" – athletes, coaches and staff. Parents and visitors will be allowed in proximity to the race corral only to the extent that safe distancing can be maintained.
