<u>Additional Safety Measures For Speed Events</u>: Per USSA and VARA guidelines, course will be restricted to Coaches and athletes only with no movement once a run has begun. All gear is to be stored outside of course area.

<u>Awards:</u> Awards will take place ½ hour after the completion of the Race Run, in the courtyard near Verde and Equipe.

<u>Parent tickets:</u> No discounted Parent Tickets available for skiing. Parents wishing to ski must purchase tickets online prior to race day: <u>Stratton Online Ticket Sales</u>

Walking Tickets (valid for 1 chairlift ride up with walking down) are available at the ticket window on the day of the race. Cost is \$20 for adults and \$15 children.

The race trail is Frank's Fall Line. You can walk up the Yodeler trail.

Stratton Mountain Mask Policy:

Masks are required in all public places.

Lodge Access Information:

Stratton Resort has restrooms available at all open lodges. All racers and families should use the upstairs of Mid Mountain lodge during the race. This area has been designated for racers and their families. Masks are mandatory while in the lodge unless actively eating or drinking.

Lift Line/Lift Riding Information:

Masks must be worn properly at all times while riding in the Gondola. Masks are not required to ride the chairlifts, but the safety bar must be down per VT State Law.

Stratton's Spectator Policy:

In an effort to maintain the safest race environment possible, the mountain is restricting the race area, (including the finish corral) to only "key personnel" – athletes, coaches and staff. Parents and visitors will be allowed in proximity to the race corral only to the extent that safe distancing can be maintained. There will be no Announcer or Scoreboard.
