COVID-19 Guidelines & Information

Should any member of your team or staff become symptomatic within 48 hrs of the race, DO NOT BRING THEM. Contact the RA for possible refund. If any member of your team or staff become symptomatic during the day of the race, it must be reported to the COVID Coordinator immediately and the person shall be removed from the venue. Team Captains must have a plan to get this person home or to health care.

Mask Policies: Masks are required in all public indoor spaces throughout Warren and Waitsfield (including Sugarbush Resort).

Sugarbush Resort Mask Policy: Masks are required in all public indoor spaces. **Lodge Access Information:** Sugarbush Resort lodges offer limited access for bathroom use and food purchase only. No bag storage is available at this time. It is suggested that the athletes return to the vans between runs for warming and food OR rent a warming cabin on Sugarbush.com

Lift Line/Lift Riding Information: The safety bar must be down per VT State Law. **Parking/Parking Lot Information:** Team van parking will be in **Lot 6**, please follow the direction of the Sugarbush Greeter when you arrive at Mount Ellen.

Food & Beverages: Multiple options available at Mt. Ellen including Cafeteria, Pub food, and a Japanese Food Truck.

- VARA + USS&S entry protocol prevails
- The GMVS Clubhouse remains closed to all visitors in 2022
- Only pre-registered Coaches may attend races. Lift Voucher Codes will be distributed via email and must be redeemed online (*Can be used with any pre-existing SBush media RFID, so if you have one in a drawer somewhere, it will save you \$5!)
- A \$100 Fee will be strictly enforced for failure to return a bib
- All race documentation will be posted on https://livetiming.usskiandsnowboard.org/
- Times will be displayed digitally only (Livetiming & onsite Digital Displays)
- Awards to 10th, Men & Women
- HEATED Base Cabins available for rent at Mt. Ellen Base (contact Sugarbush Customer Service for info)
- Please respect all posted Sugarbush rules and regulations. Tickets will be pulled for noncompliance.
- No indoor bag storage or changing areas will be provided (unless renting a warming hut)
- Restroom use available in Lodge. Please follow ALL signage/rules regarding traffic flow and social distancing.
