

Cochran's Ski Club Town Meeting Day Slalom March 7, 2023

Race Format:

- Age groups: U8 (2015 & 2016 birthdays) and U10 (2013 & 2014 birthdays)
- Race Trail: I-89
- Panel Slalom
- 4 Runs Boys and Girls: Two runs on each course, alternating courses each run (red blue red –blue). Odd bibs on red course 1st run. Ranking by better run on each course.
 - 1st and 4th runs-bib order- U8 girls, U10 girls, U8 boys, U10 boys (grouped by club within age groups, random within club)
 - 2nd and 3rdruns- reverse bib order within class and gender

Race Day Schedule:

- Registration/Bib Pick-Up: 8:30 9:00 by coach/team captain
- Jury and Course Setting: 8:00 lift
- Lift open for athletes: 8:45
- Course Inspection: 9:00-9:45
- First Run: Girls 10:00, immediately followed by Boys
- Second Run: approximately 11:30
- Coaches' Race immediately following boys 2 run (*more info below)
- Awards: 15 minutes or less after completion of coaches' race (top 10 U8, top 10 U10, each run, each gender)

<u>Coaches' Race:</u> A Town Meeting Day tradition! At least one coach from each club should plan to race (don't forget your helmet!). Sign up at team captain's meeting or bib pickup, or via WhatsApp during the race. Bibs for coaches' race will be distributed at the start.

Registration: \$25, online only at adminskiracing.com before 5:30 pm on Sunday 3/7. All racers need current USSS license and VARA membership, and must be represented by a USSS licensed coach. Racers outside of NVC welcome. <u>Team Captain's Meeting:</u> The TCM will be held virtually at 7:00 PM on Monday, 3/6/23. All coaches who have registered on Adminskiracing will be emailed a link to join. We will also be using WhatsApp again this year to facilitate communication before and during the race.

<u>Parent Lift Tickets:</u> Parent tickets are available at the lodge for \$10. Kids 5 and under ski free with the purchase of a parent ticket. Spectators are allowed this year. If you are watching on the hill, please stay outside the b-netting and be mindful of other skiers and riders using the hill.

<u>Directions to Cochran's:</u> From Interstate 89 at Exit 11 in Richmond proceed east on Route 2 to Richmond Village. Turn right at the stop light onto Bridge Street. Continue on Bridge Street over the red bridge to the Old Round Church (on left). Just past the Round Church turn left on Cochran Road. Drive approximately one mile; the ski area is on the right. Please obey posted speed limits on Cochran Road as Richmond Police patrol it regularly.

<u>Parking:</u> Upper and lower parking lots available. Parking space is limited. If possible, please carpool. A limited amount of drop off parking is available in the upper parking lot. Please clear the drop off area after dropping off your racer. Please do not park on Cochran Road; we have been informed cars will be towed if parked on the road.
