OPEN RACE: 2nd year U14's , U16+ VT and out of state racers all welcome

Race Format:

- Race Trail: I-89
- Slalom- Men 27 mm, Women 27 mm
- 2 Runs Men and Women: 1st run seeded on USSA points (list 1923), top 15 random; 2nd run bibbo flip 30, first run DNFs and DSQs run last (in bib order).

Race Day Schedule:

- Bib Pick-Up by team captain or designated coach: 8:30– 9:00
- Jury and Course Setting: 8:15
- Course Inspection: 9:00- 9:30
- First Run Women: 10:00, followed immediately by Men
- Second Run: approximately 1:00
- Awards: immediately after completion of 2nd run.

Team Captain's Meeting: The TCM will be held virtually at 7:00 PM on 3/24/23 using Google Meet. All coaches who have registered on Adminskiracing will be emailed a link to join. We will also be using WhatsApp again this year to facilitate communication before and during the race.

Registration: Registration is online at adminskiracing.com. Fee is \$75, which includes pancake brunch for all racers. VARA team can use the online system. Coaches should also register on adminskiracing.com.

Directions to Cochran's: From Interstate 89 at Exit 11 in Richmond proceed east on Route 2 to Richmond Village. Turn right at the stop light onto Bridge Street. Continue on Bridge Street over the red bridge to the Old Round Church (on left). Just past the Round Church turn left on Cochran Road. Drive approximately one mile; the ski area is on the right. **Please obey posted speed limits on Cochran Road as Richmond Police patrol it regularly.**

Parking: Please follow all instructions from our parking attendants. Upper and lower lots available. Limited drop-off parking is available in the ski area upper lot. **Please do not park on Cochran Road; cars may be towed if blocking any portion of the road.**
