## Race Format:

- Dual Panel SL
- 2 runs Men & Women (running order U12 Women, U12 Men, U14 Women, U14 Men)
  - o 1<sup>st</sup> run Random Order
  - o 2<sup>nd</sup> run Reverse Bib order from 1<sup>st</sup> run
- After two race runs the top 8 Men and Women for U12 and U14 will compete in a run-off

## Schedule:

- 7:15 ...... Jury and Course Setting Chair Lift
- 7:30 9:30 ... Registration at the Clubhouse on Sterling Mountain (Cash or Check only)
- 8:15 ...... Team Captain's Meeting at the Score board
- 8:30 9:15 ... First Run Course Inspection
- 9:30 ..... First Race Run
- Second run will be Immediately after 1<sup>st</sup> run
- After second run there will be coaches race
- There will be a 45 Minute break before the start of the run-off
- Awards 30 minutes after completion of run-off

Registration, Bib Pickup, Lodge Space: Please collect your bib from the registration table in the SNSC Clubhouse next to the T-Bar on Sterling Mountain between 7:15-8:45 AM. The entry fee will be \$20, cash or check will only be accepted at registration. Tickets for the BBQ can be purchased for \$5 at registration, or at the time of the BBQ. Please use the Base lodge to get ready and store your gear because we have limited space in the ski club and a full slate of weekend programs taking place.

**BBQ:** The BBQ will cost \$5 per person, and will start after the completion of the 2 race runs which is planned to be about 11:30. There will be hot dogs and hamburgers, salads, chips, and beverages available. Awards will take place after the BBQ.

<u>Directions to Smugglers</u>: Smugglers Notch is located on route 108 S. The only access is from the North during the winter since the notch road is closed. From Route 15 you turn onto route 108 S in Jeffersonville and follow it up to the Smugglers Notch Resort. To get to the upper mountain you continue past the main entrance to the resort up route 108. Parking will be on your right and the driveway to the base lodge will be on your left. If you wish you can continue past these options to the upper parking lot which is around the corner up to where the notch road is closed (this is ski in and out access only)

<u>Parking:</u> Parking is available in the two main lots across from the base lodge driveway. The Upper Parking lot is available for racers or coaches that want to ski from their car and ski back to it at the end of the day. Please don't park in the club member parking lot at the end of our driveway.
