Blizzard/Technica Vermont Cup Slalom

Cochran's Ski Area, Richmond, Vermont

Race Format:

- Race Trail: Race Trail (to the left at the top of the t-bar)
- Slalom - Women 27 mm, Men 30 mm
- 2 Runs Men and Women:
 - o 1st run - seeded based on points (list 917), top 15 random
 - o 2nd run - Bibbo flip 30/ finish order; first run DNF's and DSQ's run last in bib order

Race Day Schedule:

- Bib Pick-Up- 8:00 - 9:00 in ticket booth (left of lodge)
- Jury and Course Setting - 8:00 lift
- Lift opens for Athletes - 8:30
- Captain's Meeting – 8:45 at the finish area
- Course Inspection – 9:00 - 9:45
- First Run – 10:00
- Second Run- approximately 12:00
- Awards- 30 minutes after completion of second run; top 3 overall and top 3 U16, each gender

Registration: Registration is online at adminskiracing.com. VARA team can use the online system. Other comped athletes and those requiring mail-in registration, please contact Wendy Gagliardi at wgagliardi@gmavt.net. ABSOLUTELY NO REGISTRATION WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER NOON ON 2/2/17 AND NO REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED AFTER THIS TIME. All racers need current USSA license. Coach tickets can be picked up at the snack bar inside the lodge.

Race Fee: \$65 plus online processing fees

Parent Lift Tickets: Parent tickets are available in the lodge for \$10. Kids 5 and under ski free with the purchase of a parent ticket.

Directions to Cochran's: From Interstate 89 at Exit 11 in Richmond proceed east on Route 2 to Richmond Village. Turn right at the stop light onto Bridge Street. Continue on Bridge Street over the red bridge to the Old

Round Church (on left). Just past the Round Church turn left on Cochran Road. Drive approximately one mile; the ski area is on the right. **Please obey posted speed limits on Cochran Road as Richmond Police patrol it regularly.**

Parking: Upper and lower parking lots available. If possible please carpool. A limited amount of drop off parking is available in the upper parking lot. Please clear the drop off area after dropping off your racer. **Please do not park on Cochran Road; we have been informed cars will be towed if parked on the road.**

Race Day Medical Plan

Trails: I-89 and Race Trail

Race course is manned by race officials and Ski Patrol. Sled and patroller will be at top of course. Patrollers rotate as needed.

Treatment facilities:

Immediate care and care for minor injuries (bumps, bruises, etc) at the base lodge Ski Patrol room, which is fully equipped for basic first aid.

For more serious injuries, Richmond Rescue (ALS) Ambulance is dispatched from the Richmond village (5 minutes from ski area). Patients will be transported to the University of Vermont Medical Center, a Level 1 Trauma Center, in Burlington, VT (30 minutes from ski area).

If Richmond Rescue is unavailable, UVM Rescue ambulances serve as backup.
